Can I Access

POPULAR SERVICES AVAILABLE UNDER COMMONWEALTH HOME SUPPORT PROGRAMME (CHSP)

- Domestic Assistance such as cleaning, washing or ironing
- Meal preparation and assistance with eating
- Social Support Individual visits, accompanied activities e.g. shopping
- Social Support Group day clubs and Wellness Centres
- Personal Care such as showering, dressing or grooming
- Home Maintenance such as rubbish removal, lawn mowing and gardening
- Transport and shopping
- Connecting with others such as group activities and outings, day centres, companionship and peer support groups
- Respite Care including home respite, overnight respite or day respite in one of our Wellness Centres with many social and recreational activities on offer.

At a Glance

WHAT IS CHSP?

CHSP is a funding subsidy programme by the Australian Government.*

It enables Senior Australians requiring low-level or short term support to access services that help maximise their independence whilst living safely and comfortably in their own home.

IS CHSP FOR ME?

CHSP is available to those who are:

- Requiring short term or low-level support CHSP funding is available until your needs increase at which time you will transition to Home Care Package (HCP) funding.
- · Over 65 years.
- Over 50 years (or over 45 years for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders) if on a low income, are homeless or at risk of being homeless.

*Please note: the subsidy programme does not necessarily fund the full cost of services, so each person may pay a small contribution for each service that is delivered. Your coordinator will discuss this when we commence services.
