


Discover Catholic Healthcare

Specialised Care

Allied health services

Each of our Homes has a number of visiting or online allied health professionals who are available to you. Our service providers may include:

- physiotherapists
- podiatrists
- dentists
- · dietitians
- occupational therapists
- speech pathologists.

Dementia care

We provide personalised lifestyle plans designed to support both individuals living with dementia and their caregivers. Our purpose-built dementia care environments offer a safe, homely and comforting setting, thoughtfully designed to meet the unique needs of each person.

Palliative care

Our palliative care services are designed to support carers and the person with a life-limiting illness to live well with dignity, comfort, and meaning — for as long as possible. We focus on expert symptom management, emotional and spiritual support, community involvement, social and compassionate care for residents and their families.

Spiritual and Pastoral care

All our Homes have qualified and dedicated Spiritual and Pastoral Care Coordinators who provide inclusive, person-centred support tailored to the diverse spiritual and emotional needs of our residents. Pastoral and Spiritual Care is supported by research that shows the positive links between mind, spirit, and physical health. It is part of our commitment to care for the whole person.

Psychogeriatric care

Catholic Healthcare fosters a supportive community with highly-trained, professional teams in all of our Homes to ensure you receive the best in specialised care. This may include seasoned psychiatrists, psychologists and a dedicated nursing team, each possessing specialised training in psychogeriatric care.

Enhanced Services

Catholic Healthcare offers Enhanced Services to provide extra support, comfort, choice, and control in all our Homes. Our Enhanced Services include social outings, wellbeing programs, additional in-room extras, and a range of dining and beverage options. Enhanced Services are optional and are available to purchase through the Catholic Healthcare App, once you become a permanent or respite resident.

Permanent care

Permanent care refers to long-term residential care for seniors who need ongoing, high-level support with aspects of daily life, including personal care, medication management, and access to health services. We offer personalised, flexible care plans, aimed at enriching your health and wellbeing.

Respite care

Catholic Healthcare provides short-term, or respite stays for those individuals who are approved for Residential Respite Care. Respite stays can be booked for a minimum of two weeks at a time and is dependent on the Home having capacity. Longer respite stays may be available on a case-by-case basis. The basic daily care fee is charged each day for respite and must be paid in full on arrival for a minimum two weeks period.

Our Foundations Program

All our Homes offer a foundation program, focusing on the leisure interests through social, emotional, physical, spiritual, cultural and cognitive wellbeing, enriching the experiences that enhance comfort, creativity and connection in daily life. Our Foundations Program offers a range of activities suited to the resident's choice including, but not limited to:

Hummingbirds: A music and movement program designed for all mobility levels, with light exercises that keep residents active, engaged, and having fun.

Engage volunteer program: Stay connected through visits from our trained volunteers, who offer companionship and support aligned with national standards.

Playgroup NSW intergenerational visits: This intergenerational program connects residents with young children to share stories and build joyful memories.

One-on-one wellbeing visits: Daily visits from our Lifestyle Team tailored to each resident's interests and needs, including comfort care visits through a non-medical approach that promotes choice, dignity, and meaningful engagement.

Thrive with dementia: Offered in Memory Support Units as the specialised equivalent of our Foundations Program and including carer involvement.

Together, these programs support your mind, body, and spirit — helping you feel truly at home.

1 Register with My Aged Care

Please visit **myagedcare.gov.au** to register. Have your address, phone number, Medicare, and pension numbers handy.

2 Assessment and eligibility

After you have registered with My Aged Care, a member of your local assessment team will arrange to visit you to determine your eligibility.

3 Choose your new home

Call us on 1800 225 474 and we can help you find a Home based on your needs and location. We recommend booking a free tour with one or more of our Homes to get a feel for the community.

4 Calculate your fees and get independent financial advice
